



Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium Environmental Education Summer Internship

Position Available: Environmental Education Internship (2-3 positions available)

Description: The Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium seeks individuals who are enthusiastic about environmental education to work with us this summer. Students range from pre-K through adult, with the majority being in early education through middle school. Primary responsibilities will be to assist our instructors during summer camp programs. Additional responsibilities may include guided tours of the Hatchery & Aquarium, hands-on outdoor programs, mommy and me classes and birthday parties. Programs focus on freshwater aquatic ecosystems and nearby salt marsh and woodland habitats.

Hours: Full day and half day sessions available. Summer camps run from July 1 to August 16. Preparations for camp programs will begin the last week of June.

Qualifications:

- Background in biology, environmental science or education.
- Interest in education.
- Must be enthusiastic and enjoy working with children.
- Must have flexible hours.
- Must be comfortable handling fish, turtles and amphibians.
