Description: The Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium seeks individuals who are enthusiastic about environmental education to work with us this summer. Students range from pre-K through high school. Primary responsibilities will be to assist our instructors during summer camp programs. Programs focus on hands-on activities, nature crafts and outdoor adventures to nearby freshwater, salt marsh and woodland habitats.

Hours: Full day and half day sessions available. Summer camps run from June 29 to August 21. Preparations for camp programs will begin the last week of June.

- Must have flexible hours.
- Must be comfortable handling fish, turtles and amphibians.
