Position: Per diem Environmental Educator/Summer Camp Instructor (seasonal position)

Description: The Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium seeks an individual who is enthusiastic about environmental education to work with us on a per diem basis. Students range from pre-K through high school. Primary responsibilities will be teaching our summer camp programs. Camps include nature crafts, hands-on activities and outdoor adventures to nearby freshwater, salt marsh and woodland habitats. Additional responsibilities may include guided tours of the Hatchery & Aquarium, hands-on outdoor programs and birthday parties.

Hours: Summer camps run from June 30 to August 14. Preparations for camp programs will begin the last week of June.

Qualifications:

- Background in biology, environmental science or education.
- Interest in early education.
- Must be enthusiastic and enjoy working with children.
- Must have flexible hours and be available throughout the camp season.
- Must be comfortable handling fish, reptiles and amphibians.
- First Aid and CPR certified.

Benefits:

- Spend your summer outdoors while sharing your love of nature and science with children.
- Seasonal per diem educators will be paid \$13/hour and receive up to 5 hours of paid training.
- Hours may be used to fulfill observation/teaching hours. Check with your advisor for approval.
