

Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium Naturalist-In-Training Program

Thank you for showing interest in becoming a Naturalist-in-Training (NIT) at the Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium. NIT's will learn what it is like to work at a summer camp while gaining leadership skills and participating in fun, outdoor adventures. You will work in a team as you assist Hatchery education staff and become small group leaders during camp activities. Throughout the summer you will have an opportunity to participate in at least one week of camp.

Naturalists-in-Training must be at least **13 years old**, entering **8th grade** in September 2021, and have participated in **Junior Biologists** in previous years. The Junior Biologists requirement can be waived on a case-by-case basis for students entering grades 9-12.

To become an NIT, your application must be received **before June 1st**. Applications will be placed in the order they are received. Spaces are limited so send in your application early. Applications received after June 1st will only be accepted if spaces are available.

A **mandatory orientation** for all NIT's will be on Monday, **July 1st** from 10am-3pm. During orientation we will discuss your responsibilities and practice techniques while visiting the salt marsh and Franklin's Pond. You will also receive a Hatchery T-shirt.
