## Fly Fishing Techniques

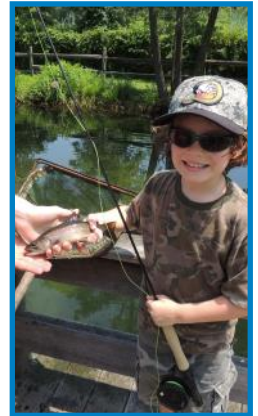
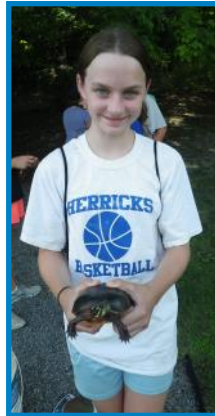
