Position Available: Environmental Education Internship (multiple positions available)

Description: The Cold Spring Harbor Fish Hatchery & Aquarium is looking for individuals enthusiastic about environmental education to join us this summer. Students range from kindergarten through high school. Primary responsibilities will include assisting our instructors during summer programs, focusing on hands-on activities, nature crafts, and outdoor adventures in nearby freshwater, salt marsh, and woodland habitats. Interns must be able to effectively interact with the public, follow and enforce all necessary rules, remain on their feet for extended periods, be comfortable leading activities with multiple participants, and be prepared to learn about and utilize basic plant/animal identification, as well as first aid.

Hours: Full-day and half-day sessions are available. Summer programs run from the last week in June to August 14. Preparations for programs will begin in late June.

Qualifications:

- Background in biology, environmental science, or education.
- Interest in education.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must be enthusiastic and enjoy working with children.
- Must have flexible hours.
- Must be comfortable handling fish, turtles, amphibians, and aquatic invertebrates.

Benefits:

- Spend your summer outdoors while sharing your love of nature and science with children.
- This is a volunteer position. Hours may be used for college credit or to fulfill observation hours. Check with your advisor for approval.
