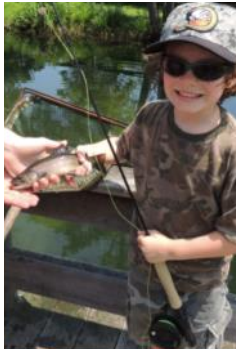
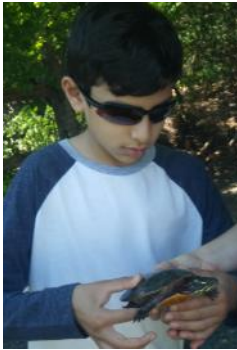


Turtle Trackers
